

Practical Fire Awareness Training

Effective fire safety awareness training for you and your staff, including practical training on the safe use of portable fire extinguishers.

Fire Safety Training - an Employer's Responsibility.

It is a legal requirement for all employers to ensure that all members of staff are adequately trained in the precautions they need to take in respect of fire safety, the action to take in the event of a fire, and the proper use of fire safety equipment. This is covered under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999, and the The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.



What Courses Are Available?

Argos Fire Protection Ltd offer three different courses which compliment each other:

- Basic Fire Safety Awareness Training (Online Course) - See separate leaflet
- Fire Safety Awareness Training (Classroom-based and Practical Course)
- Fire Warden/Marshall Training (Classroom-based and Practical Course)

What is Covered on the Course?

The two practical courses both consist of classroom based learning with a talk, videos and question & answer session; and practical fire extinguisher training (including live fire where conditions allow).

- Types of fire
- Types of extinguisher
- Correct use of fire equipment

Fire Warden - as above, plus:

- Theory of combustion
- The duties of the fire warden
- Staff training and fire routines

- Active and passive fire protection
- Recognising risks and electrical safety
- Daily checks

Certificates are issued to all attendees on completion.

Where and When are the Courses Held?

The Fire Safety Awareness Course is generally for one company at a time, and is held at your premises (where possible), or at a convenient nearby location, at a time to suit you. This course is designed for up to 20 persons at a time and takes between 2 and 2½ hours. Multiple sessions can be held in one day at a discounted rate.

The Fire Warden Course is a full day course that can be provided at your premises (and tailored to your specific requirements), or we hold a course at a training venue in Exeter approximately every three months or as demand requires.
